**Herpes-Type Virus Particles Associated with a Fungus**

A culture of the fungus *Thraustochytrium*, isolated from an estuary, was infected by an enveloped virus. The nucleocapsid measured 110 nanometers in diameter and contained a core of DNA. The virus replicated in the nucleus. These findings strongly suggest that the particles are a herpes-type virus.
