Abstract

The effect of different nootropic drugs (piracetam, pyritinol, meclofenoxate, methylglucamine orotate, dihydroergotoxine, nicergoline, vinpocetine) on the duration of immobility in the behavioural despair test in mice was studied. All tested nootropics exhibited a dose-related reduction in immobility. In connection with the discussed role of monoaminergic processes in the state of immobility our data
